HUMAN ERROR

Every minute of every day media overtakes our attention to the other things happening around us. How many of the million distractions above are taking place in the cars around you? Think of how often you see drivers around you looking down or away from the road. Nearly 10% of all driving fatalities are caused by distracted driving. Sadly, around 25% of distracted drivers in fatal crashes are between the ages of 20 and 29; at least 48% of young drivers admit to distracted driving; and about 75% of all fatalities occur among young males under 25.
